**Church buildings and property except for Parsonage:**

Established in 1736, the Halifax Congregational Church structure was built in 1852 in typical quaint New England style. An addition was built approximately forty years ago and houses our Fellowship Hall and Sunday School classrooms. A new Memorial Rose Garden, located next to the church entrance was dedicated in 2002. An ample parking lot, directly behind the church, borders conservation land, Town Hall, and the Central Cemetery. The church is located in the Halifax Historical District, in the heart of Plymouth County; and was the site of the first Sunday School in America in 1736.

**Parsonage : 506 South Street, Halifax, MA**

The Parsonage is a comfortable cape style home located across the street from the church, near the Holmes Public Library, Town Hall, Elementary School, Senior Center, and Post Office. It borders the Halifax Historical Village and conservation land. It has three bedrooms and a full bath on the second floor, and a kitchen, living room, library (or additional bedroom), den and a half-bathroom on the first floor. There is also a full basement and one car garage under the house.
